Eligibility: Any student who is currently enrolled in a North Dakota school - Kindergarten - 12th Grade.

Categories: Grades K-3, Grades 4-6, Grades 7-8, Grades 9-12.

## **Entry Fees:**

Fee rate is \$8 per every 5 pieces submitted. *No pro-rating.* (If only submitting one piece, the fee is **\$8**) There is no limit to the number of pieces you can submit. Make checks payable to Taube Museum.

## Medium:

Any two-dimensional media is acceptable. Size limit, including mat, is 24" x 26". Digital Media Division - Any 2D works created using computer programs, photography, photo manipulation or graphic design. Stretched canvas are acceptable with cardboard on the back, the size of the canvas, then shrink wrapped to protect the canvas. Canvas boards also must be shrink wrapped. This protects the piece from damage while traveling.

# **Specifications:**

Please submit original works only. The Taube will make every effort to hang and display the works that are entered. If a piece does not meet the outlined requirements (for example, if it is larger than 24x26 or not an original piece) then it will still be shown at the Taube, it will just not be eligible for awards.


# Identification:

All pieces of artwork must have an identification label attached to the lower right corner of the back of all work. Please number the individual student works with the corresponding inventory number from the Master List. For each work submitted, include a duplicate label in an **unsealed envelope, facing away from the art work, in the Iower left corner. Please complete the enclosed master list form** along with payment. Please use copies of the label, which have been provided in the prospectus.

### **Presentation Information:**

All work must be matted, backed with heavy cardboard or foam core, covered in acetate or shrink wrap (no glass, frames, or clear bags with seals please) and ready for hanging. The museum will

check entry qualifications prior to hanging the show. No work will be accepted if it is not ready for hanging. Attach string or wire (fishing line and yarn are not acceptable) to back tabs by tying. Be sure that hanger is a proper length, and does not extend above the top of the artwork when hung. Please mat pieces (or float mount) to allow for placing of award label, using at least a 2 inch mat or border. No pins attaching the string to the cardboard. No holes through the cardboard backing and simply tying a knot to the other side - they pull through the holes! Use packing tape ONLY to secure tabs. (Masking tape/scotch tape are not acceptable).



# Return of Artwork:

It is the responsibility of the teacher submitting the work to arrange for return of the artwork. Entries returned by mail will be returned COD, unless other arrangements have been made. Be sure to enclose a check and/or with instructions for shipping. (Due to new postal regulations, we are unable to accept stamps for returns).

Entries must be shipped in a reusable container (e.g. sturdy cardboard box). Works not complying with these specifications will not be opened. Artwork that was not selected for the traveling exhibition may be picked up at the Taube Museum of Art starting April 30, 2025. Your 2024-25 pieces may be picked up when you deliver your works or will be returned at the close of the current exhibit, unless other arrangements are made.

# **Responsibility:**

Every reasonable caution will be taken in the handling of artwork, but the Taube Museum of Art does not assume responsibility for loss, damage or deterioration before, during or after the exhibition. Entry fees are non-refundable.

# WAIVER OF ORIGINALITY

Artworks submitted must be original pieces completed by a currently enrolled high school student. The following does not count as original artwork:

- Studies of other artist's work
- Celebrity portraits
- Artworks made based off of any photograph not taken by the student themselves
- Reproductions that use a different media than the original piece
- Artwork of existing characters not created by the student ie manga, cartoon, anime, etc.
- Artwork based off of another artist that is not transformative\*
- Prints of an original piece. For example, a printed copy of a painting by the student.

\*Transformative works are new works that add value, substantially change, comment on, or give a new expression or meaning to the source. The following does not count as transformative art:

- Changing the medium of the original work. For example, creating a pencil drawing based off of a photograph is not transformative.
- Cropping or resizing someone else's image
- Artworks that only make minor changes to someone else's work. For example, changing the hair color or clothes of a celebrity in a photograph.

While studies of other's work do not count as an original piece, painting an original idea in the style of a master is considered transformative. For example, a painting of an original idea by the student in the style of Van Gogh is considered transformative. The content of the artwork must be the student's original idea, and not derived from an outside source.

By signing this waiver of originality, the school representative acknowledges that all student works being submitted to the North Dakota Student Art show are original pieces adhering to these guidelines. Even if you have permission to use a work or if the work is in the public domain, the work that is submitted must represent a new, original work. Artwork submitted that is not considered original is not eligible for hanging, touring, or judging. It is the school's responsibility to ensure that all works submitted are original pieces.
